Building up a Socialist Country: Primary School English Textbooks in Post-War Yugoslavia

ABSTRACT: In early socialist Yugoslavia, the entire educational policy was oriented towards raising up all schoolchildren in the spirit of socialism to which aim all textbooks, including textbooks for learning foreign languages, were adjusted. The purpose of this paper is to show how the 1950s primary school English textbooks were used as a medium of ideological indoctrination. Its thorough content analysis showed that the textbooks promoted the idea of a "good pioneer" (the one who contributes to the country by learning diligently, participating in voluntary youth labour projects, cherishing the cult of Josip Broz Tito, etc.), the idea of modern collective farms organised after the nationalisation of large landholdings as well as the idea of industrialisation and electrification that both governed the path of Yugoslav post-war economic development.

The publishing activity of the *Ekpeudeutikos Omilos* (EO) (Books and magazines) during its operation (1910-1930)

ABSTRACT: This announcement refers to the publishing activity of the *Ekepdeutikos omilos* (EO), an Athenian union with philological deviations, urban character and goal the reformation of Greek education. His action from 1910 to 1930: publishing production of books, enlightening and children's library articles. The publications were relatively limited in scope and quantity but with a new perspective, pedagogical approach and use of the primary language. From 1917 to 1920, the supply of EO books was attempted by the Ministry of Education for the staffing of the courses of the senior supervisors. Also, the «DEO» (magazine of EO before the split) had articles, studies, current affairs texts on educational, pedagogic, language mainly issues while the new magazine «Neos Dromos», after the split, echoed the left-wing orientation of Glinos, with texts of his own and others on the criticism of educational current affairs and the presentation of the educational programs of socialist countries.

Several demonstrations in his memory have taken place after his disappearance, including a conference in April 2019 which reconstructed his multifaceted activity as a politician, writer and above all school manager. Cervellino has emerged as a model for those who have recognized education as an essential element of reconstruction, on a par with politics and the economy, of Basilicata after the Second World War.

ABSTRACT: The authors present a first study about some mathematics texts for children written by Carlo Lorenzini (Collodi) between 1884 and 1889. In addition to his most famous literary works, Pinocchio's father, in fact, wrote a series of didactic booklets for boys and girls of the lower cycle of elementary schools, which

were published in the «Collana Scolastica» of the Paggi publisher in Florence. These booklets consist of the socalled *Giannettini series*, centered on the character of Giannettino, as well as two *Libro di Lezioni* respectively for the Second and the Third elementary class (1889). Here the lesser known *L'Abbaco di Giannettino per le scuole elementari* (1884) will be analysed and compared with the *Lezioni* of 1889, with respect to mathematics content, literary style and teaching approach used by Collodi.

ABSTRACT: The National Recovery and Resilience Plan has once again placed the issue of guidance at the center of the relationship between schools and universities. The literature on the subject agrees on the fact that guidance can no longer be limited to a circumscribed action but must qualify as an educational activity to be carried out throughout the life of the subject, for which pedagogy as an educational science plays a fundamental role. In the elaboration of an educational conception of guidance, a peculiar and significant place – with particular reference to the Catholic sphere – must be attributed to three scholars of the last century: H. Wallon, A. Gemelli and A. Agazzi. The first laid the foundations of a humanistic vision of guidance, the second recognized guidance in terms of educational need, the third formulated a real pedagogy of guidance.
